

### EFFECTIVE PRIVATE



If you're not HIV positive, you can obtain a free preventive treatment to avoid infection. Its name is "Prep", and it has been available in France for 10 years.

Prep is a pill to swallow. You take it every day, on a continuous basis or only during certain periods, depending on your sexual activity.

The pills come in blister packs or in small bottles.

#### SIMPLE & FREE



Anyone age 15 and over has the right to take Prep.

But to get Prep you need a prescription from a doctor, who will support you in this preventive treatment. Prep can be obtained in any pharmacy with that prescription.

This medicine is completely free.

## WHAT ABOUT OTHER INFECTIONS?

Prep requires regular medical followup, which helps quickly detect and treat other sexually transmitted infections (STIs).

Even if your partner takes Prep, the best way to protect yourself is to take Prep yourself.



# FOR EVERYONE

You can have access to Prep if you benefit from France's state medical assistance (aide médicale de l'État - AME) or its solidarity supplementary health insurance (Complémentaire santé solidaire - CSS).

Foreigners not eligible for this medical support in France can apply to receive Prep through any CEGIDD, which are centers that supply free information, screening and diagnosis of HIV and other infections. AIDES and other associations can support you in this application process.
